

The Cuneiform Short Alphabet Series Bibliography and Abbreviations

This bibliography reflects the works I have consulted in writing about the various texts in the short cuneiform alphabet from Ugarit and elsewhere. It is a living document in the sense that I plan to update it as I post new pieces on these texts or update older ones. Most of the entries directly reference the various texts. However, a few, like Cohen (1989), are included because I used them to inform my interpretations even though they have little direct bearing on the texts themselves. In at least one case (i.e. Pritchard [1975]), I cite accidentally the same work multiple times. This is done to facilitate references where differing contributors to the same work are involved and identifiable. The format of each entry is as follows: the author(s) last name(s) followed by the date of publication in parenthesis. Where an author(s) has more than one referenced publication in the same year, I have used the letters b, c, and so forth after the date to differentiate these publications. A colon follows this. The material before the colon reflects the way the entry is cited in the various posts. The material after the colon is a full formal reference to the work. I have tried to make these as complete as possible. Among the bibliographical entries are a few abbreviations that I use from time to time in my posts.

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
